



ROLE OF THE ENTRANTS SPONSOR

1. Each entrant in the Miss Wagga Wagga Quest is required to have a Sponsor.
2. An entrant's sponsor can be a business, an organisation or an individual willing to provide the sponsorship fee of \$675.00 for the entrant to be eligible to participate in the 2019 Miss Wagga Wagga Quest.
3. The sponsorship fee is used to fund the personal development of the sponsor's entrant.
4. Personal development is an important aspect of the Miss Wagga Wagga Quest as it provides the entrants with opportunities to develop their confidence. To achieve this, a series of personal development sessions are planned to ensure entrants can confidently undertake the many tasks before them in the coming months. Entrants will be given sessions, where possible and time permits in:
 - Meeting procedure;
 - Function organisation and budgeting;
 - Time management;
 - Personal grooming including dress sense, hair and make-up; and
 - Deportment and speaking in public; and etiquette.
5. The sponsorship fee is also used to provide entry to official Quest events such as the Launch of the Miss Wagga Wagga Quest and the celebrations following the Crowning of 2019 Miss Wagga Wagga and Community Princess. Complimentary tickets to the Launch and the Crowning Celebrations are issued to both the Entrant's Sponsor and the Entrant.
6. In return for their sponsorship, an Entrant's Sponsor is acknowledged at functions and during promotion of the Miss Wagga Wagga Quest fundraising by the entrants. These opportunities include:
 - At the Launch of the Quest when the Entrant is introduced and throughout the Quest on the Sponsors banner displayed at all functions;
 - during interviews on radio (both 2WG and 2AAA FM) by the entrants when publicising the Quest and its fundraising functions;
 - during interviews for the print media (The Daily Advertiser and Riverina Leader);
 - during interviews on television when publicising the Quest and its fundraising functions; and
 - in the official programme for the Crowning Ceremony and at the celebrations following the crowning.
7. When acknowledged at official Miss Wagga Wagga Quest events, Entrants' Sponsors are individually introduced to those present as part of the official proceedings. Sponsors are encouraged to attend the launch, crowning and events so that they can be acknowledged in person.
9. A Miss Wagga Wagga Entrant sponsor is not a Quest beneficiary.
